

Possible Strategic Priorities 2019 – 2020

Quarter 1

Health – Medicines Management – Relationship between GP's, Hospitals and Patients

- Looking at the patient experience of prescribing practice in Hospitals and GPs. What differences are there and what impact is this having on patients.

Social Care - Personal Budgets

- This is a follow up on historic concerns on what impact personal budgets have had on service user experience. How have personal budgets impacted on people.

Public Health – Social Prescribing

- Due to the importance being placed on Social Prescribing in recent NHS and public health plans, we will look to gauge public understanding of social prescribing. Is the VCS still able to offer sufficient support to this model.

Quarter 2

Health – Access to Secondary Mental Health Care

- This will look to build on insight received from the public to answer the question - What is the patient experience of accessing secondary mental health services?

Social Care – Supported Living services

- After local issues and national concerns about supported living, we will look to build a clearer picture of what the services are like locally for service users and their families.

Public Health – Life style services

- Following local review of how lifestyle services are provided locally, we will look to better understand what impact these changes have made. How are these services supporting the early intervention and prevention agenda.
